Incident Date and Time: Friday, June 9, 2017, at about 2:30 pm
Location: Millbrae Public Library, City of Millbrae
Incident: Stabbing
Suspect Information: 44 year old male, South San Francisco resident
Charges: Willful injury to a child, Attempted murder (Felonies)

Summary:

On the above date and time, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the Millbrae Public Library on the report of a stabbing. Upon their arrival they were directed to the suspect who was found standing in the courtyard in front of the library. The suspect resisted but was immediately taken into custody.

After speaking with witnesses, Deputies learned the suspect approached a 13 year male who was standing in the courtyard and without motive began to stab him with a 4 inch folding knife. The victim escaped the attack and fled into the library. The suspect did not follow and remained in the courtyard.

Since Deputies arrived within seconds after the attack, they were able to provide the victim with first aid. The victim sustained injuries to his arms and was transported to a local hospital. He is expected to recover.

The suspect was arrested and booked into the San Mateo County Jail and is being charged with willful injury to a child and attempted murder. Due to the ongoing investigation, the suspects name is not yet being released.
