Incident Date and Time: Saturday, December 2, 2017 at approximately 7:00 PM
Location: Burton Park, 900 Chestnut St. City of San Carlos
Type of Crimes/Incident: Armed Robbery

Suspect Information: Described by the victim as seven to eight males possibly Black, wearing dark colored hooded sweatshirts with partially covered faces.

Suspect Vehicle: Black Honda sedan or similar

Summary:

On Saturday, December 2, 2017, at approximately 7:00 pm, seven to eight subjects described as possibly black males wearing dark clothing approached a 15-year-old male victim. One of the suspects presented what is believed to be a black handgun and demanded the victim's cell phone.

The suspects took the cell phone and fled towards Woodland Avenue. Some fled on foot and others possibly in a black colored newer model Honda sedan or similar type. Deputy Sheriff's searched the area and did not locate any suspects.

The victim was not injured during this incident. This crime is still under investigation and there have been no other similar reports.

The Sheriff's Office reminds citizens to always be aware of their surroundings especially after dark and report any suspicious activity.
