Type of Crimes/Incident: Shooting
Suspect Information: Unknown

Summary:

On Friday, December 22, 2017, at 11:45 am, Sheriff's Office Deputies responded to the area of Marlborough Avenue and Berkshire Avenue in unincorporated Redwood City on the report of a shooting.

Upon their arrival, they located two male adult victims with gunshot wounds. Both were transported to the hospital and are currently recovering.

Investigators learned that as the two victims were walking, they were approached by an unknown male suspect who shot them. The suspect then fled in an unknown vehicle. Information suggests this shooting is gang-related and that victims were specifically targeted.

Sheriff's Office Deputies have increased patrols in this area and are reminding the public to report any suspicious activity. At this point, there is no suspect information and the investigation is still ongoing.
