Incident Date and Time: Thursday, March 2, 2017, at about 11:00 am
Location: 100 block of Wayside Road, Town of Portola Valley
Type of Crime/Incident: Residential Burglary

SUSPECT: Unknown race male, 6 foot tall, wearing a dark grey hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans.

SUMMARY:

On Thursday, March 2, 2017, at about 11:00am, Sheriff's Deputies responded to a residence on the 100 block of Wayside Road in the Town of Portola Valley on a report of a residential burglary.

Upon arrival, Deputies learned the above suspect forced entry into the home by smashing the glass on a rear door. The suspect was scared off when he encountered the home owner inside. The suspect fled to a waiting red sedan that was being driven by a second unknown suspect. The suspect vehicle fled before the victim could get any additional information. The vehicle was last seen traveling northbound on Portola Road. An area check was conducted with no signs of the suspects.

The homeowner was not injured. Personal property was taken from the home and this incident is still under investigation. The Sheriff's Office reminds residents to remain vigilant and report any suspicious persons or activity.
