Summary:

On, Saturday, March 4, 2017, at approximately at 3:15 am, Deputies from the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office responded to the Shops at Oceano (200 block of Capistrano Road in Princeton), on a report of a possible commercial burglary in progress. Two subjects were observed attempting to steal the ATM from inside the mall. The subjects gained entry to the mall by smashing a large plate glass window. The suspects fled in a grey colored full-size pickup truck, prior to the deputies arrival.

Responding deputies observed a vehicle matching the description at the intersection of Highway 1 and Kelley Avenue in Half Moon Bay. An enforcement stop was attempted. The suspects failed to yield and continued eastbound on Highway 92. The California Highway Patrol continued the failure to yield and followed the suspect vehicle until it crashed in the City of San Jose, where the two suspects were taken into custody.

It was later learned that a business in the 100 block of Main Street, Half Moon Bay was also the victim of a commercial burglary. Sheriff's Deputies believe that the incidents are related and the investigation is on-going.

Both subjects were transported to the San Mateo County General Hospital for minor injuries sustained during the crash and were later booked in to the Maguire Correctional Facility for the above charges.
