Incident Date and Time: Monday, April 10, 2017, at about 9:00 am
Location: 100 block of Golden Oak Drive, Town of Portola Valley
Type of Crime/Incident: Residential Burglary

SUSPECT: Three unknown suspects wearing dark clothing

SUMMARY:

While out of town a homeowner received a motion alert from his home security system. Using his smartphone, the homeowner was able to see security video showing three unknown suspects wearing dark clothing standing on his property.

Sheriff's Office Deputies responded to the residence located on the 100 block of Golden Oak Drive, in the Town of Portola Valley. Upon their arrival, they searched the residence, located a smashed rear window and learned some personal property had been taken. The suspects fled in an unknown direction prior to the deputies' arrival. Deputies searched the area but did not locate any suspects.

This incident is still under investigation.
