**Location:** El Camino Real (State Highway 82) / San Diego St., Millbrae, CA

### Summary:

Millbrae, CA - On Thursday, May 4, 2017, at approximately 10:30 pm, Deputies from the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office – Millbrae Patrol Bureau were dispatched to a report of a vehicle striking a pedestrian collision on northbound El Camino Real at the intersection with San Diego Street. Upon arrival, Sheriff's Deputies learned a pedestrian was walking east within the crosswalk and was struck by a green Ford Mustang that was travelling north on El Camino Real.

The driver of the Ford Mustang, a 70 year old female, San Bruno resident, remained at the scene and cooperated with the investigation. The injured pedestrian, a 47 year old female, Redwood City resident, sustained serious injuries as a result of the collision and was transported to a local hospital where she remains in critical condition.

The San Mateo County Sheriff's Office Major Accident Investigation Team (MAIT) is currently investigating the accident.
