Location: Portola Valley Fuel, 105 Portola Road, Portola Valley
Type of Crimes/Incident: Stolen credit card reader "skimmer"
Suspect Information: Suspects unknown

Summary:

Portola Valley, CA- On Monday, March 19, 2018, at approximately 5:20 am, two unknown male adults pried open a gas pump at Portola Valley Fuel, 105 Portola Road, and took what appeared to be a credit card reader ("skimmer") from the gas pump.

At this time, it is unknown if there are any victims of credit card fraud or identity theft. This is an active investigation. If anyone used their Credit Card or Debit Card at Portola Valley Fuel, 105 Portola Road in the last few months, we suggest you advise your financial institution and monitor your bank/credit card accounts for any fraudulent activity.

The gas pumps at Portola Valley Fuel have been examined and there are no "Skimmers" on the machines.
