Incident Date and Time: Saturday, 6/30/18 between 9-10:30 pm

Original Incident Location: Pillar Point Boat Launch Ramp, Half Moon Bay

Type of Crime/Incident: Sexual assault of a juvenile

Suspect Information: A White male adult in his forties, 5'09", chubby to medium build, brown hair (full head of hair), brown beard (short and shaggy), wearing a red hoodie sweatshirt and jeans, overall he was described as dirty.

Summary:

On Saturday, June 30th, between 9:00 pm and 10:30 pm, a 14-year-old female was walking her dog in the area of the Pillar Point Boat Launch Ramp parking lot in Half Moon Bay. An unknown male subject approached the juvenile and inappropriately touched her. The juvenile was able to defend herself and she fled the area.

The incident was not immediately reported to law enforcement. Detectives met with the victim today and she was able to provide the above description.
