Incident Date and Time: Sunday, September 23rd, 2018 at approximately 12:01 am
Location: 1200 Block Toyon Drive Millbrae, Ca.
Type of Crime/Incident: 212.5(a) PC- Home Invasion Robbery (Felony)
460(a) PC- Burglary (Felony)
245(A)(1) PC- Assault Causing Great Bodily Injury
182(A)(1) PC- Conspiracy
Suspects: Three (3) dark skinned male adults, armed with handguns wearing face coverings.
A U-Haul box truck is thought to be associated.

Summary:

On Sunday, September 23, 2018, at approximately 12:01 am, San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a residence on Toyon Drive, on the report of a home invasion robbery that had just occurred. Prior to the deputies' arrival, the suspects fled the scene in a U-Haul truck in an unknown direction.

Investigation determined three male adults armed with handguns wearing ski masks entered the residence. Once inside, they confronted the victims, tied them up and demanded valuables. The suspects took an undetermined amount of money, ammunition, tobacco and two safes. One of the victims suffered injuries to her head from being struck.

Sheriff's Detectives have reason to believe this incident was not random and that this home was specifically targeted. The community at large should still be vigilant, but nothing leads us to believe there is a threat to the general public.

We want to remind the public to always secure doors, windows, garage doors and side gates.
