Summary:

On Tuesday, October 2nd, 2018, at approximately 11:20 pm, San Mateo County Sheriff's Office deputies were dispatched to a suspicious person looking through the window of a residence on the 2300 block of Howard Avenue. A passerby confronted the suspect after which they were involved in a minor scuffle. The suspect was last seen running towards Dayton Avenue. The passerby was not injured during the scuffle and did not require medical attention. Deputies searched the area, but were unable to find the suspect.
