**Incident Date and Time:** Thursday, February 8, 2018 at 6:30 pm  
**Location:** 100 block of Old County Road, City of San Carlos  
**Type of Crimes/Incident:** Fatal incident of vehicle vs pedestrian

### Summary:

On Thursday, February 8, 2018 at 6:30 pm, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 100 block of Old County Road, in the City of San Carlos on the report of a blue Toyota Corolla striking a pedestrian. When they arrived they located an adult male with injuries lying in the roadway. The man was being treated by paramedics but did not survive his injuries.

The driver of the Toyota, a 70 year old Belmont resident also remained on scene and is fully cooperating with the investigation.

Our Sheriff's Office Major Injury Investigation Team (MAIT) responded to the scene. They are working to determine the cause of this incident. At this time drugs or alcohol do not appear to be a factor. This incident is still under investigation.
