Incident Date and Time: Thursday, February 22nd, 2018 at approximately 5:00 am
Location: 200 block of Poplar Avenue, Half Moon Bay
Type of Crimes/Incident: Suspicious shooting
Suspect Information: *None*

Summary:

On the above date and time, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 200 block of Poplar Avenue in Half Moon Bay. Upon their arrival, they located an adult female with a single gunshot wound to her head. The female was treated at the scene but ultimately transported via Life Flight to a local hospital, where she remains in critical condition. At this time, we are working to determine if the gun-shot wound was self inflicted or not. The firearm was collected and processed for evidence. There was a male adult on scene who made the original 911 call. He was questioned and we do not have any suspects in custody at this time. This investigation is ongoing.
