Summary:

San Mateo County Sheriff Carlos G. Bolanos, Congresswoman Jackie Speier, Assemblymember Kevin Mullin, and Board of Supervisor David Pine were all present at this weekend's Gun Buyback event, which turned out to be a great success. We had a large turnout and received 427 guns for destruction, including many assault rifles. Several of the attendees also made donations to the Gun Buyback program while attending the event.

We greatly appreciate the support that we've received from our elected officials including Congresswoman Jackie Speier, Congresswoman Anna Eshoo, and Assemblymember Kevin Mullin, as well as the County Board of Supervisors, and our Law Enforcement partners and participating cities within San Mateo County. We'd also like to thank Chief Dan Mulholland and the Redwood City Police Department for partnering with us to help make this event successful.

Sheriff Carlos G. Bolanos said "The Sheriff's Office and the Citizens for a San Mateo County Gun Buyback group collaborated with other local cities and delegates to make our county a safer place to live and work. This was demonstrated by the results we saw on Saturday with 427 guns removed from our communities. This program was well supported by many and very successful in contributing to that mission."
