Architectural Renderings:

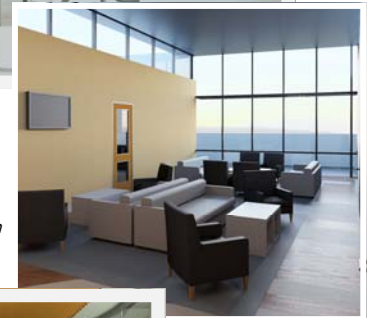

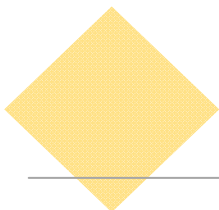

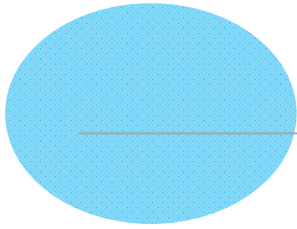

The office trailer provides an open working environment (called the Big Room Concept) and fosters constant communication between JPU, the construction manager —Sundt Layton, and the architect firm—HOK. JPU also utilizes the expertise of Sares Regis Group as the Owner's Representative.

The owner representative assists JPU team members in reviewing and commenting on the projects architectural concepts; as well as analyzing the construction schedule and safety program adherence.
